All other **9 Hole Players** - Front 9 or 6 Hole - Scramble

Tees: **Blue** (6005) - 18 Hole High School Boys
Gold (5185 yards) – 18 Hole Middle School Boys
Gold (5185 yards) – 18 Hole Girls Division
Green (4535 yards) - PGA Junior League
Yellow Fairway Stakes - See scorecard

Rules for Spectators

**** Golf Carts permitted - May assist players due to inclement weather.**
**** May not come within 30 yards of player during the course of play.**

Pace of Play: **Players are responsible for maintaining position with the group ahead or skip holes.**

Maximum Score: When TEAM has hit shots **equal to double par** on that hole and has not holed out.....pick up ball. The score for that hole is double par +1.

Scorecards: **Players are required to return signed and attested scorecards.**

Play all lost balls as a Lateral Water Hazard. Drop ball from where last seen....one stroke penalty.

Ties: Ties for 1st place only - Chip Off All other positions shall stand.

Rain-Out: Tournament will be reduced to the number of holes designated by Committee. Scores may be converted to + / - in relationship to par if less than a full round.

Electronic Measuring Devices: Permitted

Player's Club Rules: All tournament policies shall apply including rules for **SPECTATORS** (30 yards)

Local Rules

Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf and Decisions and, where applicable, the following Local Rules. Any changes or additions will be supplied on a supplementary rules sheet.

Embedded Ball: “Through the green” a ball that is embedded in its own pitch-mark in the ground may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay, but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.

“Through the green” is defined as all areas of the course, except the teeing ground and putting green of the holes being played, and all hazards on the course.

Dropping Zones: In addition to the options available under Rule 26-1, a player may drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke, as follows:

- Beside #1, #3 and #6 putting greens for balls that last crossed the margin of the lateral water hazard beyond the putting green.
- Before the water hazard on hole #13 for balls that last crossed the margin of the water hazard left of the path.

Coquina Shell Areas: Except for the coquina path crossing #4 fairway, all coquina paths and coquina natural areas are “through the green”.

Concrete & Paved Paths: All concrete and paved roads and paths on the golf course, and the coquina path crossing #4 fairway are deemed to be immovable obstructions. Relief without penalty is provided under Rule 24-2.

Distance Measuring Devices: Players may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only.

Putting Green Edging Grooves: Under local rule 33-8/24, if a ball lies in or on an edging groove around a putting green, or if the groove interferes with the area of the players intended swing, the ball may, without penalty, be lifted, cleaned and placed in the nearest position to where it lay that is not nearer the hole and avoids interference by the condition, whether on or off the putting green.

Safety Considerations:

- Fire ant hills are deemed to be ground under repair. Relief without penalty is provided under Rule 25-1.
- Please do not search for balls on the practice range during play.
- On hole #10, please do not cut the corner from the teeing ground.
- **DO NOT** search for lost balls in a WATER HAZARD....due to possibilities of alligators.
